1. The company or organization, if a "for hire" company offering services (such as training) to third parties on a commercial basis, shall offer no other national crane operator certification program, in order to avoid confusion of the CCO acronyms and logo with another program not in compliance with, nor under the control of, the National Commission for the Certification of Crane Operators. This does not preclude a company from issuing a certificate of completion of training, which is preparation for the CCO examination(s).
2. The company or organization shall submit a written proposal for **each intended use** of the CCO logo or acronyms, including a copy of any proposed artwork. The company must receive written permission for **each different/updated use** from the National Commission for the Certification of Crane Operators.
3. The company or organization shall place the following wording in a prominent position adjacent to each CCO logo used:

"[Company XYZ] fully endorses the national certification program offered by the National Commission for the Certification of Crane Operators (NCCCO)."

"The company" and "[Company XYZ]" refer to the company applying for use of the logo and/or acronyms.

NOTES

1. This purpose of this agreement is to facilitate approval methods for companies using the CCO logo and the CCO acronyms.
2. The CCO logo and the CCO acronyms are the exclusive property of the National Commission for the Certification of Crane Operators. They may not be used without prior written permission. Any unauthorized use will be grounds for compensatory or other legal action.
3. NCCCO encourages the authorized use of the CCO logo and the CCO acronyms. NCCCO does not charge for their use in the above manner if approved in writing by the National Commission for the Certification of Crane Operators. Logos are available electronically in various formats, upon email request, free of service charge.

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By signing below I agree to the foregoing terms and conditions regarding the listing of my firm or organization on the NCCCO web site, as well as the use of the NCCCO and CCO logos and acronyms. I understand the terms, conditions and limitations of any listing my firm may or may not receive as a result of this application. I agree to make no false or misleading statements with regard to CCO examination pass/fail statistics in any printed or electronic materials. I further agree, as a condition of being included on the list of NCCCO's practical test sites, that NCCCO may, from time to time, and either with or without notice, monitor the testing procedures utilized by my firm or organization. If I am also acting as a test site coordinator, I agree to comply with all the requirements pertaining to this role as listed in the NCCCO Test Site Coordinator Handbooks. I understand that failure to meet the terms of this agreement at any time may result in my listing as a practical examination test site being denied, suspended, or revoked.
